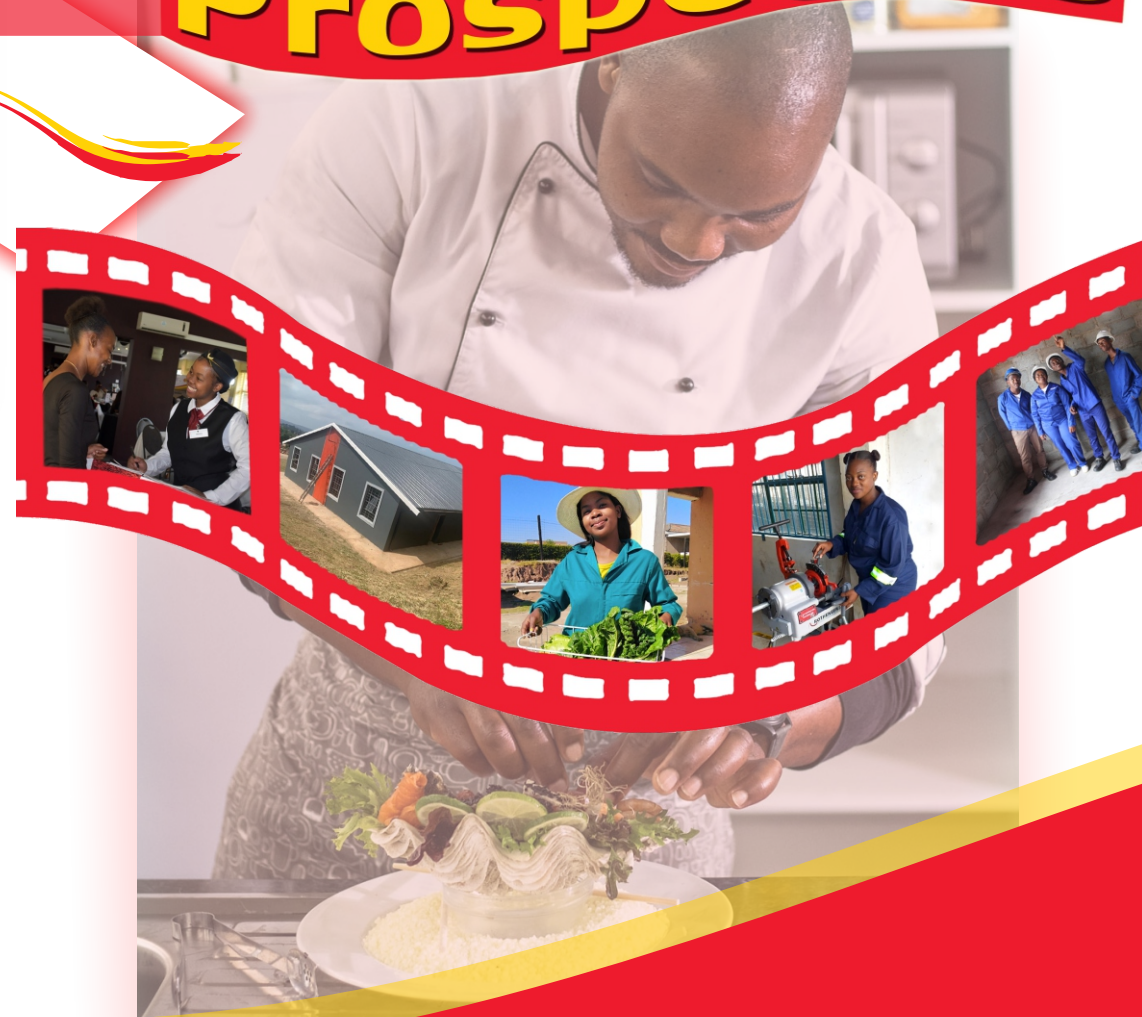

NB: AS OF 2017, NSFAS BURSARY APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE DONE ONLINE (www.nsfas.org.za)

- All new applications must be submitted directly to NSFAS online (www.nsfas.org.za) to create MYNSAFAS account.
- Students who have never received NSFAS funding or who have taken a gap year must apply online.
- Students who received bursary the previous year, do not have to reapply. They must login into www.nsfas.org.za to create the MYNSAFAS account to verify their details.
- All students who have been previously funded by NSFAS and not funded in 2020 must apply online.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED WHEN APPLYING FOR NSFAS

NATIONAL CERTIFICATE (VOCATIONAL)

Public TVET Colleges now offer a new, exciting, modern and relevant range of vocational programmes known as the National Certificate (Vocational). These programmes are high skills, high quality and high knowledge programmes introduced nationally in 2007 and are intended to directly respond to the priority skills demands of the economy.

The NCV is currently offered at levels 2, 3 and 4 of the National Qualifications Framework (NQF). The NCV is designed to provide both the theory and practice. The practical component of study may be offered in a real or stimulated workplace environment. It provides students with an opportunity to experience work situations during the period of study.

What is the Duration of the Qualification?

The NCV qualification is a full year programme at each of the NQF levels of study. A student is issued with a statement on successful completion of each level of study. Ideally students should complete all three levels and thereby complete the full level 4 qualification.

What subjects make up a National Certificate?

In order to obtain an NCV qualification, a student is required to take a total of seven subjects. These include three Fundamental subjects (English First Additional Language, Mathematics / Maths Literacy and Life Orientation) and four Vocational subjects, 3 are compulsory and 1 is optional. The seven subjects will complete the qualification at each level.

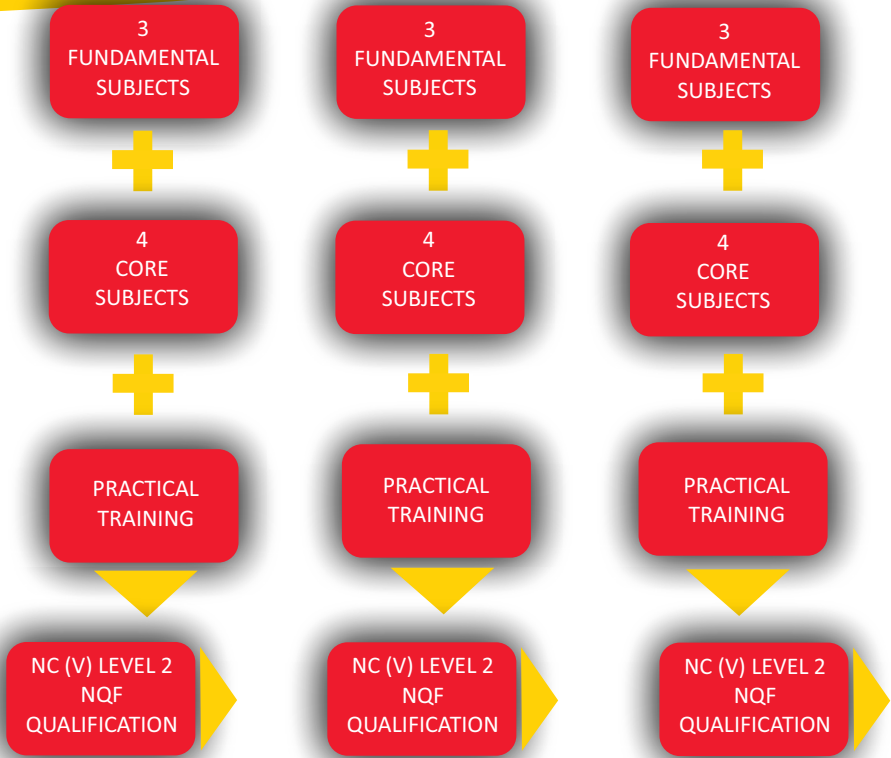
What is the minimum entry requirement for NQF Level 2?

The minimum entry requirement is a Grade 9 pass (or equivalent). However, the NCV programmes are very challenging and are ideally suited to students with a higher existing qualification.

To qualify for the Diploma Level, all the credits for the Certificates Level must have been completed and the student deemed competent. All relevant Certificate Level in-service training must have been completed. In-service training for each level contributes to approximately 20 - 40 credits per programme and has to be completed before any certificate is to be expected. Students are expected to do additional research and must have the ability to use the internet.
