GENERAL INFORMATION

NATIONAL CERTIFICATE VOCATIONAL NQF LEVEL 2,3 & 4

The DHET introduced the NCV at all public TVET Colleges to offer students an opportunity to study various vocational qualifications.

The programmes are intended to directly respond to the priority skills demands of SA economy.

The NCV is offered at Levels 2,3 and 4 of the (NQF)
National Qualification Framework.

The qualification is designed to provide both theory
and practical experience in a particular vocational
field. The programme consist of 7 subjects.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A prospective student should have at least a year-end school report for Grade 9 or higher, or an NQF Level 1 qualification for access to NQF level 2

Registering students with the college are expected to write compulsory capability test (CAP TEST) which will determine into what course the prospective student should enrol. CAP TEST is compulsory to all first year entering students.

DHET COLLEGES FINANCIAL AID SCHEMES

The DHET FET Colleges Bursary Scheme are funds made available by government to assist students enrolled, or intending to enrol at TVET Colleges but are unable to fund their studies. The funds are made available through NSFAS, but it is not a LOAN.

- Submit certified copy of your ID, parents/guardians Ids and proof of income or sworn affidavit if proof is not available.
