- ⓔ The college offers a range of short courses which are flexible and can be offered according to company needs (e.g. languages, computer packages etc.) See the section on Skills Training (pg 8) for further details.

ABOUT TVET

uMfolozi College is one of nine public Technical and Vocational Education & Training (TVET) Colleges in KwaZulu-Natal, and one of 50 in South Africa. But, what is a public TVET College?

Public Technical and Vocational Education & Training (TVET) Colleges, which fall under the governance structures of the Department of Higher Education & Training, strive to provide high-quality education and training to help equip yourself with the qualifications and skills you need to start out on a chosen career path. At a TVET College you gain invaluable life skills to meet the many challenges of the working world, not just a paper qualification.

Public TVET Colleges also work closely with role players and stakeholders from various industries to help fulfill the great need that exists for trained, skilled and qualified employees through customized education and training programmes.

TVET Colleges are able to offer the following qualifications:

➤ National Diploma

A National Diploma (M+3/NQF5) Qualification is awarded to students who have completed their N4 – N6 in a specific field at a TVET College, and are able to provide proof that the required relevant in-service training period has been completed.

The full duration including completion of studies and in-service training is usually 3 years.

➤ National Certificate (Vocational)

A range of vocationally based programmes introduced at TVET Colleges in 2007. See pg. 7 for further details and a schedule of NC(V) programmes offered at uMfolozi College in 2023.

➤ Artisan Training and Trade Testing See pg. 17

➤ Skills programmes

Short duration skills based programmes offered by TVET Colleges, usually from rurally located skills campuses. See pg. 8 for a schedule of skills training programmes offered by uMfolozi College.

➤ Co-operative Training & Support

This is training for young people on the fundamentals of establishing and managing a youth co-operative business. A co-operative is an autonomous association of persons united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social, and cultural needs and aspirations through a jointly-owned and democratically-controlled enterprise. 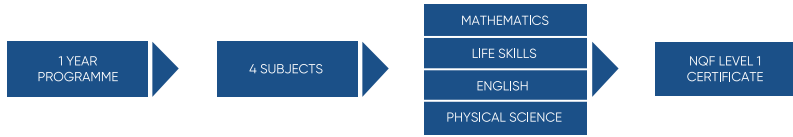
➤ Learnerships

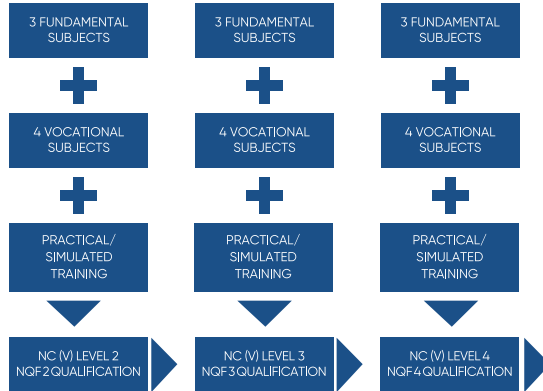

TVET PROGRAMMES STRUCTURE

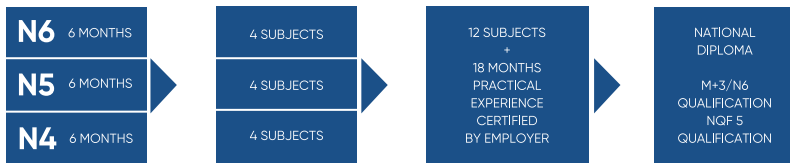
PRE-VOCATIONAL LEARNING PROGRAMME (PLP)



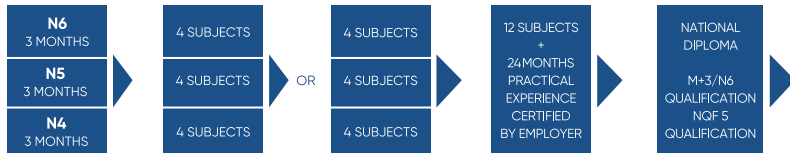

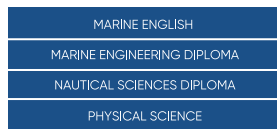

Course Type	Pre-Vocational Learning Programme (PLP)
What is PLP?	Pre-vocational or pre-technical education programmes are mainly designed to introduce participants to the world of work and to prepare them for entry into further vocational or technical education programmes
How long does it take?	1 Year
Which qualification / certificate does a learner obtain on completion?	Certificate NQF Level 1
Who is PLP for?	Pre-vocational Programme is for anyone with Grade 9 and it is given before a vocational programme.
Resources	NSFAS Bursaries available for financially and academically qualifying students

Course Type	National Certificate (Vocational) NC (V)
What is NC (V)?	The National Certificate (Vocational) is a new set of national qualifications designed to provide people with high level of marketable skills. Each of the programmes provides in-depth knowledge in its specific field, opening doors to NC (V) graduates in a range of occupations within its specific field.
How long does it take?	3 Years (1 year per level). Each of the 3 NC (V) levels currently offered take 1 year to complete. Ideally students should complete all 3 levels.
Which qualification / certificate does a learner obtain on completion?	Full Certificates on NQF Level 2, 3 and 4 NC(V) Level 4 Certificate is equivalent to National Senior Certificate (matric)
Who is NC (V) for?	NC (V) is for anyone who want to gain the knowledge and practical skills necessary to assess their dreams career. The minimum entry requirement is Grade 9/NQF L1 Qualification + college requirements set per programme. The programme is very challenging and is well suited to with higher qualifications who want to access a specific field.
How and when can you apply?	The College will have a college date for all applications preferably September / October of the application year.

- Work placement office assist both Report 191 and NCV students to obtain the necessary practical experience they need. However, this does not relieve students of the responsibility for finding suitable host company.
- In order for placement office to place Report 191OR Level 4 students, they must have passed all their modules. This application does not apply for engineering students as they can be placed from N2 up to N6 for skills programs. Student must submit his/ her CV to the placement office.
- NCV level 4 students are also given the opportunity for experiential learning over a period of 5/10 days. All level 4 WBE be placed according to the program to be placed on that particular year.
- The college does not have a budget to pay stipend to all students who are placed for the in-service training. Students receive stipend if the college has been awarded funding from the Seta's.
- An agreement must be signed between the college, the student, the SETA and host employer. This agreement must outline the responsibilities of all parties.
